We need more jobs

When more than half a million people are unemployed, it also affects those in work. Because the more people we have in work, the stronger the Swedish economy becomes. Which enables us to invest more in public services. Furthermore: a person with a job has a context, greater freedom and more scope to shape their future.

- **Make it cheaper to employ people.** Employment taxes must be abolished for young people, the long-term unemployed and the first employees in growing companies.
- **It must always be worth it to take up a job.** Reduce taxes on low incomes and make sure that it is always worth it to make the move from benefits to work.
- **Make it easier to run a company.** Away with cumbersome regulations.

Emissions must be reduced

When we invest in the climate, we also invest in tomorrow's jobs and public services. Cheaper green electricity is good for you, for business and for the climate.

- **More low-cost electricity.** Large-scale expansion of electricity generation and halving the lead times for grid expansion and connections.
- **Reduce taxes and charges on electricity,** so that both domestic and business users are better able to make the transition from fossil sources.

- **Encourage the growth of green industry.** With long-term rules of play, clear climate ambitions and enhanced support. Halve the lead times for climate tech companies by speeding up permit processes.
- **Make it profitable to make the transition.** More money must stay where the electricity is generated. Reduce taxes on renewables, bring in a proper electric vehicle bonus nationwide and a tax reduction for green technology in the home.

Healthcare, education and social care must work for more people

When we are at our weakest, when we are ill, when we are children, when we are older and finding it harder to manage the things we used to do, this is when society must be there to lend a hand.

- **Healthcare, education and social care must work across the country.** Wherever you live, you have a right to receive good healthcare when you need it, to your children being able to attend a school that both sees and teaches them, and to help and peace of mind for your grandmother.
- **Record investment in the mental health of young people.** Initiate support promptly, boost the student health service and expand psychiatric services for both children and adults so that more people can access help when they need it.
- **Better conditions and higher wages in the welfare sector.** Those who work in healthcare must be better paid. Older employees who are willing to do so must be able to work for longer.

Sweden deserves more.

You deserve a government that takes the major issues seriously.

That makes sure that people have a job to go to in the morning and gets the country's economy moving again. That makes sure that emissions are reduced and Swedish business can be a world leader in the climate transition. That cuts healthcare waiting lists, makes sure that children have a better education, that grandma gets help in whichever part of the country she lives, and that healthcare staff do not experience burnout.

You deserve a government with both mind and heart. That pursues a tough legal policy, but does not try to put children behind bars. That wants to sort out migration policy – recognising that, for example, expelling people who are law-abiding and who study, work and contribute to society is both unreasonable and uneconomic. That believes that it must always be worth going to work, which is precisely why we want to cut taxes for those with the lowest wages.

You deserve a government that does not go to extremes, neither to the right nor to the left. We are convinced that people benefit from having more control over their everyday lives. You should be judged by what you do, not by the colour of your skin or your title. Sweden was built on a solid foundation of trust, openness and accountability. This is why we want to keep those on the fringes of politics away from executive power.
